

Entry requirements

1 – DEFINITIONS

ITS Contest 2027 (hereinafter “ITS Contest 2027”) is a creative platform for emerging designers. Since the first edition in 2002, it has attracted more than 15.000 fashion, accessories, and jewellery design talents from more than 80 countries and across all continents.

It is a contest that includes a 10-day long collaborative residency at ITS Arcademy – Museum of Art in Fashion in Trieste, to which a selection of applicants will be invited to join in March 2027.

The selection of applicants (hereinafter “selected designers”) is made by an international Jury composed of fashion industry leaders, artists, stylists, photographers and editors. They benefit from global media exposure, professional opportunities and mentoring, as well as financial support.

Judging criteria takes into account creativity, innovation and social and environmental responsibility.

Each of the 10 selected designers will receive a:

1. €10,000 cash prize.
2. 10-months feature in the “BE LOVED” Exhibition at ITS Arcademy - Museum of Art in Fashion
3. 10-days Residency, which will take place in Trieste on March 7th-17st 2027. A unique experience packed with hands-on activities, workshops, talks, seminars and interviews with peers and industry mentors.

ITS Arcademy – Museum of Art in Fashion is Italy’s first contemporary fashion museum, a place of creative discovery and learning designed for everyone, where visitors can explore fashion as a form of contemporary art.

The Museum Collection archives 15.643 creative project portfolios, 1.318 garments, 189 accessories, 120 jewelry pieces and over 700 photographic works, preserving them for future generations.

ITS Contest and ITS Arcademy – Museum of Art in Fashion are both projects of Fondazione ITS.

Fondazione ITS is a private foundation dedicated to giving visibility by leveraging multiple platforms and audiences, engaging jurors and press through expert opinions and media coverage. Museum visitors contribute to on-site visibility, creating a tangible connection between the selected designers’ work and the public. Additionally, the goal is to amplify the visibility on the digital networks, reaching a broader and more diverse audience online.

2 – ELIGIBILITY

ITS Contest 2027 is open to:

- Recent graduates and students graduating in 2026
- Emerging Fashion, Accessories and Jewellery designers
- Teams of maximum two people

Collaborations in the development of innovative materials and techniques are welcome.

Please note that the presence of brands in conflict with our Partners' interests in the pieces could result in applicant's disqualification.

The project must not be applied in any other competition taking place in Italy in 2027. If an applicant is selected for any other competition, Fondazione ITS must be informed immediately.

3 – TIMELINE

Submission Deadlines:

- **Digital Portfolio:** September 21st, 2026
- **Physical Portfolio (only if requested):** starting from mid-September 2026
- **Designers' Selection:** Mid-November 2026
- **Pick up of donated outfit/item:** December 1st - 4th, 2026
- **Residency & Final Event:** Two weeks in March 2027 - March 7th - 20th

4 – CATEGORIES

FASHION

- No prefixed styles, categories, seasons, or themes.

ACCESSORIES

- Footwear, belts, hats, bags, eyewear, bodypieces.
- The collection may be a combination of the above categories.
- A pair of shoes counts as 1 item. It is possible to enter a single right or left shoe.

JEWELLERY

- Necklaces, rings, brooches, earrings, bracelets and any other kind of jewellery.
- The collection may be a combination of the above categories.

5 – APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- **Digital portfolio:** must be submitted by **21 September 2026** (see Art. 5.1).
- **Physical portfolio:** required only upon request (see Art. 5.2).
 - Submission of the physical portfolio is mandatory if requested.
 - Failure to provide it will result in disqualification.
- **Shipping arrangements and costs:** organised and covered by Fondazione ITS.
- **Pick-up deadline:** the physical portfolio must be ready for collection by 14 October 2026.

Important: physical portfolios will not be returned under any circumstances.

5.1 - DIGITAL PORTFOLIO PREPARATION

A digital portfolio must be submitted by and no later than September 21st 2026 – the applicant must complete the online form with the following material:

- CV in English.
- One passport-size photo.
- Concept of the enrolled project.
- Portfolio (pdf format) must include all details of the development process (sketches, digital materials, draping, etc.).
 - If the creative process involves drawing either by hand or digitally, it is compulsory to include examples.
 - Photos of each outfit/piece. Photos of work in progress are accepted if outfits/pieces are incomplete.
 - Overview of all outfits/items applied on one A4 size page, in landscape format.
 - Fashion Film (NOT MANDATORY)
 - Video presentation: the applicants have to make a video selfie answering the following questions:

1. What's your name?
2. Where are you from?
3. Tell us about a moment in your life when you felt loved. What did it mean to you, and why? The love could come from anyone or anything — a partner, your parents, your audience, the universe, your cat, or yourself. However you read BE LOVED — show us the one moment it stopped being a word and became something you felt.
4. Greet us in your own language.

Specs: portrait format, maximum duration 30 seconds.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Pause 2 seconds between one answer and the next!

Although not mandatory upon application, submitting the video(s) is strongly encouraged, as it provides crucial insights and frequently serves as a determining factor during the selection process. **Please note that if not provided initially, this video could still be requested during the next stage of the selection process:**

- Video of the portfolio: a short video presentation in which you may choose to flip through your physical portfolio and briefly introduce your concept, research, and development process.

Specs: landscape format, maximum duration 2 minutes.

Please note:

- All photos and videos can be used for communication purposes and for jury evaluation; pay attention to the quality of both audio and image.
- Photos, videos and Fashion Films must be fully credited in case of third parties collaboration.

IMPORTANT NOTES

- Any collaboration with third parties in the development of the collection, innovative materials / techniques must be clearly indicated.
- Any fabric or material can be used. We suggest avoiding real fur, feathers, leather, batteries (because of shipment limitations).
- Photos of the applied collection/project are mandatory, if not included the application will not be accepted and will not be presented to the jury.
- The selected designers must produce items in full accordance with the lineup and technical details presented. Items varying greatly from the applied shapes and designs will result in disqualification.
- Items applied must be of the same collection and linked by the same concept.
- It is important to send high quality material! Sketches, photos...anything from the portfolio can be published on the Fondazione ITS website and social networks or used with the press or any other use Fondazione ITS considers viable for communication.
- Please note that the style and aesthetic value of the portfolio will be considered in the evaluation.
- The applicant might be asked to provide additional material if necessary.

5.2 – SELECTION AND PHYSICAL PORTFOLIO PREPARATION

All digital applications will be evaluated and only a selection of applicants will be invited to send the physical portfolio. The physical portfolio must include all the above (see art. 5.1 “Digital portfolio preparation”) mentioned material.

Here are the instructions on how to assemble your portfolio:

1. Pack your portfolio in a cardboard box and write the sender and receiver clearly on it.
 2. Do not insert valuable material (e.g. gold, money, technological devices...).
 3. **It is MANDATORY to include swatches and material samples.**
 4. Air Transport Restrictions: the inclusion of items typically restricted from shipment, such as batteries, should be strictly avoided.
 5. For Extra EU Shipments: in case of Extra EU Shipments, be sure to avoid prohibited items. These generally include hazardous materials, illegal goods, and items that could cause damage or pose a safety risk during transport. Examples include explosives, flammable liquids, weapons, certain types of batteries, and perishable or hazardous food items. Additionally, items like certain animal products, such as fur, feather and leather goods are also prohibited.
- In case of doubt, please refer to the main carriers shipping policy (such as DHL or FedEx).
6. Waybill will be provided via email by Fondazione ITS. Stick it securely onto the package.

6 – IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Please note:

6.1 - Each of the 10 selected designers shall receive financial support in the amount of €10.000,00. Residency-related expenses covered directly by the organization include educational activities, accommodation, daily breakfast, lunches and selected meals.

The financial support granted to the finalists includes an additional €150,00 subsistence allowance to cover expenses such as meals not directly provided by the organization. Travel expenses to and from Trieste will not be booked or paid separately by the organization, as they are intended to be covered by the total financial support of €10.150,00.

The support of €10.150,00 is intended to cover travel expenses, meal costs not directly provided by the organization, the cost of creating the outfit that will be donated to the ITS Arcademy – Museum of Art in Fashion, and the materials used in its production.

The support will be paid out in two installments, €2.150,00 before the arrival in Trieste, Italy and €8.000,00 after.

In order to make the payment of the above mentioned support, Fondazione ITS will require fiscal documentation from each participant. In Italy all money transfers to any entity are subjected to a tax withdrawal operated by the Italian government. In order to avoid double taxation and to transfer the total amount of money, a Certificate of Residence for the purpose of tax relief against double taxation must be provided. Application for this document must be made in the respective country's tax office. Further details will be provided, depending on the Country of residence.

6.2 - Communication with the selected designers will be done through email and Google Workspace. Important updates, announcements, and instructions will be sent via email, ensuring timely and direct communication. Google Workspace will be used to share and organize necessary documents, resources, and various materials. A detailed program outlining all activities and expectations will be provided in due time.

6.3 - Whilst every effort is made to ensure the safety of all submissions, Fondazione ITS cannot be held responsible for any damage or theft of garments or designs that may occur during transport, selections or during the stay in Trieste.

7 – OBLIGATIONS

In case of selection, these are the obligations:

7.1 - Required presence in Trieste, Italy for two weeks March 7th - 20th 2027. A range of activities and projects will be programmed: initiatives that involve local traditional craftsmanship, collaboration on projects with official ITS partners, participation in workshops, talks, and group work sessions as well as opportunities for professional development through in-depth exchanges with jurors. Participation in all activities is mandatory.

The finalist is required to carry out all further paperwork (Visa, passport, etc.) and other obligations in a timely manner in order to be present in Trieste, Italy.

A detailed program with all commitments and deadlines will be provided in due time. Information regarding the stay in Trieste will also be provided.

If any finalist will be unable to follow this program due to any restriction, this must be promptly communicated to Fondazione ITS.

7.2 - The selected designers are required to donate to Fondazione ITS a duplicate copy of one item, to be sent in December 2026. Fondazione ITS will arrange and cover the expenses for the pickup and shipping of the requested item. The said item will become part of the ITS Collection in ITS Arcademy - Museum of Art in Fashion and will be featured in a 10-month dedicated exhibition at the museum. The rights transfer of the donated item is regulated by the rights as expressed in article 8.

7.3 - The selected designers could be asked to bring additional outfits/items from their collection for jury and press presentations.

7.4 - There could be collaborations and projects with the official ITS partners after the ITS Contest 2027. All details and instructions will be discussed and organized directly with the partner/s. In the event of further selection, the finalist could be asked to be available to collaborate with partners for an extended period of a few weeks or more.

7.5 - Any variation of address and/or phone number must be communicated promptly.

Fondazione ITS reserves the right to disqualify any contestant at any time if they do not respect the terms and conditions of these entry requirements.

8 – PLAGIARISM & OWNERSHIP

By applying to ITS Contest 2027, the applicant guarantees the authorship and originality of their project, the collection/project, as well as any other material created and applied in ITS Contest 2027 (hereinafter “the Work”).

Should they be found guilty of plagiarism, the applicant will be automatically disqualified.

Fondazione ITS holds no responsibility for accusations of plagiarism from third parties.

Both the applicant's digital and physical portfolio will remain property of Fondazione ITS and in no case will they be returned.

The applicant will retain Intellectual Property, Copyrights and all other economic rights related to the applied portfolio and collection (hereinafter “the Work”).

Notwithstanding what is stated above, the aim to increase the awareness of ITS Contest, ITS Arcademy – Museum of Art in Fashion and ITS mission and activities and to promote the Work for the applicant's own benefit, the applicant, by signing this form, irrevocably grants to Fondazione ITS a worldwide royalty free permanent non-exclusive license:

A. to publish the Work;

B. the Work may be featured in photoshoots and filming and/or in other means for different mediums, with the purpose of advertising and promoting the applicant, ITS Contest, ITS Arcademy – Museum of Art in Fashion and ITS mission and activities and in order to create a digital database of the Work accessible to the public on site and/or on-line;

C. to present, to promote and to communicate the Work to the public also by (i) transmitting the Work via Fondazione ITS's own mass-media (website, social networks, catalogs, including other media that Fondazione ITS may launch in the future) and via national and/or international press and media; (ii) showcasing the Work in free entry or paid admission exhibitions; (iii) showcasing the Work on-site and/or by accessing to the online database - free of charge or for a fee - to those who request it for consultation for study, research, teaching and/or cultural purposes;

D. to use the Work for formative, didactical and/or educational purposes by organizing workshops, courses, seminars, either free of charge or with admission fees.

In the event that the applicant intends to assign or to license their IP rights and/or copyrights and/or other economic rights related to the work to third parties, the applicant undertakes responsibility to notify Fondazione ITS and shall be obliged to prefer Fondazione ITS to the third party under equal conditions.

For any ITS Arcademy – Museum of Art in Fashion products that are created during the residency, the finalist will retain Intellectual Property, Copyrights, while transferring all rights listed above (letter A to D) and commercial rights.

All physical materials submitted (portfolios and donated items) will remain property of Fondazione ITS. The applicant hereby takes note that Fondazione ITS makes all reasonable efforts to avoid unauthorized use of the Work by third parties and, therefore, the applicant agrees that Fondazione ITS shall not hold responsibility for any damages that may derive from illegal use of the Work by a third party.

9 – APPLICABLE LAW AND JURISDICTION

This application is executed in accordance with and governed by Italian laws. The Court of Trieste, Italy, shall have exclusive jurisdiction in the event of any disputes arising out of the fulfilment or interpretation of the ITS Contest rules and application.

10 – PRIVACY & CONSENT FOR RELEVANT DATA

Italian and European law requires the consent of a privacy release form. Accepting the ITS Entry Requirements and the art. 15 “PRIVACY STATEMENT” here attached warrants that the applicant has read the written information included concerning the treatment of personal and relevant data according to Italian law, D. Lgs. N. 101/2018, to European law, GDPR 679/2016, and is in accordance with these provisions.

11 – ACCEPTANCE OF THE REGULATIONS & DEADLINES

Accepting these Entry Requirements warrants the applicant's complete comprehension, respect and acceptance of all rules, regulations and deadlines and does not guarantee selection. In the event that any rule, regulation or deadline is breached, ITS reserves the right to disqualify any participant applied in ITS.

12 – PRIVACY STATEMENT

Fondazione ITS, with registered office in via della Cassa di Risparmio, 10, 34121 Trieste, VAT no. 01324230323, Tax Code 90112870325, as data controller (hereinafter, “Data Controller”), informs you pursuant the EU Regulation no. 679/2016 (“GDPR”) and the applicable national Data Protection law that your personal data shall be processed according to the following modalities and for the following purposes:

1. Scope of Data Processing

The Data Controller processes the following personal data, communicated by you at the time of registration for ITS Contest through the compilation and submission of the ITSWEB Entryform (<https://entryformonline.itsweb.org/>) or communicated during the execution of the professional mandate (hereinafter “Data” or “Personal Data”):

- Identifying Data such as, by way of example, name, surname, gender, date of birth, country, address, postcode, nationality, language spoken, company name, tax code, email, telephone number, identity card, profile photo, CV, information about your education (status as a student, school attended, name and course type), link to social profiles (optional) etc.;

- Browsing data: such as IP addresses or domain names of computers used by users connecting to the Site, URI (Uniform Resource Identifier) addresses of requested resources, the transmission of which is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols. This information is not collected to be associated with identified interested parties, but by its very nature could, through processing and association with data held by third parties, allow users to be identified. These data are used only to obtain anonymous statistical information on the use of the site and to check its correct functioning and are deleted immediately after processing. The data could be used to ascertain responsibility in case of hypothetical computer crimes against the site: to this effect, the data on web contacts could be kept in accordance with and limited to this purpose. Starting from the IP address and the domain name of the computers used, it will be possible, limited to the purpose of ascertaining responsibility, to trace back further identification data of the user (in particular, name, surname, e-mail address, telephone number, etc.);

- Data collected through cookies: for information relating to cookies on the Site ITS Contest, we invite you to consult the Cookie Policy <https://itsweb.org/fondazione-its/cookie-policy/>;

- Only if, in the context of the submitted portfolio/work, you will provide us with Sensitive/Particular Data such as, for example, information on racial and ethnic descent; religious, philosophical or other kinds of belief; political opinions; adherence to political parties, to trade unions, associations or religious, philosophical, political and trade-union organisations, as well as personal information on health and sexual life.

2. Purposes and Legal Basis of Data Processing

Your Personal Data shall be processed for the following purposes and legal basis:

A. Without your prior consent, your data will be processed for:

- a. the execution of the contract and/or the fulfilment of pre-contractual obligations, in particular:
 - the correct registration for ITS Contest through the completion and submission of the ITSWEB Entryform;
 - the organisation and the management of international Contest for emerging creatives;
 - the promotion of emerging creatives to journalists and commercial enterprises;
 - the management and processing of a contact request sent by the data subject through the contact form “Contact Us” on the Site;

- sending to emerging creatives reminders about their pending Entryform registration status to assist and help them on how to correctly fill out the ITS Entryform.

- b. the fulfilment by the Data Controller of legal obligations such as:

- compliance with the obligations established by laws, regulations or national and community legislation or imposed by the competent Authorities;

- c. the fulfilment of a legitimate interest of the Data Controller such as:

- the management and maintenance of the Site: the interest of the Data Controller relates to the general interest of a company to ensure business operations, including through the operation of the Site, and possible efficiencies in the service offered;

- the preservation, documentation, and archiving of portfolios, donated items, and audio-video recordings for the historical, educational, and cultural purposes of the ITS Arcademy - Museum of Art in Fashion (pursuant to Art. 89 GDPR)

B. With your consent, your data will be processed for:

- a. Marketing purposes, in particular for:

- sending of informative material on promotional activities regarding ITS.

- b. the use of your image/video and name for the realisation, publication, distribution of promotional, commercial and archival material in relation to the activities of ITS related to the ITS Contest through any means of communication, including internet and social networks:

- your personal data are processed with your prior express consent, provided by signing the Release of Declaration (see below) to carry out the activities mentioned in the Release of Declaration and expressly subscribed by you. The use of your name and images are considered free of charge.

3. Modalities of Data Processing

The processing of your Data is carried out, both via hardcopy (paper) and electronic modalities, by means of data collection, recording, organisation, storage, consultation, elaboration, amendment, selection, retrieval, confrontation, use, interconnection, blockage, communication, erasure and destruction operations.

Your personal data is subject to electronic processing. Your personal data is protected in such a way as to minimise the risk of destruction, loss (including accidental loss), unauthorised access/use or use incompatible with the original purpose of collection. This is achieved by the technical and organisational security measures implemented by the Data Controller.

4. Storage of Data

The Data Controller shall process the Personal Data for the time necessary to fulfil the above purposes, specifically:

- 10 years from the conclusion of the Contest for the administrative, legal, and contractual purposes set forth in letters a., b., and c. (site management) of subparagraph A of paragraph 2;
- Permanently (indefinitely) for portfolios, donated items, images, and audio-video recordings processed for historical, archival, exhibition, and educational purposes of the ITS Arcademy – Museum of Art in Fashion, in accordance with the exemptions for archiving purposes in the public interest (Art. 89 GDPR);
- Until revocation of your consent for marketing and active promotional purposes (subparagraph B, letter a. and b. of paragraph 2), and in any case no longer than 24 months after the conclusion of ITS Contest for active commercial campaigns. Revocation of this consent does not affect the permanent storage of the material in the ITS Arcademy – Museum of Art in Fashion historical archive.

And in any case for the period of prescription provided by law.

Please note that in case of non-submission of the ITS Entryform registration your data will not be processed and/or stored and will be immediately deleted.

5. Access to Data

Your Data may be made accessible for the purposes mentioned above to employees and/or collaborators of the Data Controller, in light of their role as persons in charge of the processing and/or internal Data Processors.

6. Data Communication

Your Data may be communicated, even without your prior consent, upon their request, to control bodies, police or judiciary bodies, the Ministry of Finance, the Tax Authority, ministerial bodies and competent Authorities, local bodies (regions, provinces, municipalities), regional and provincial Tax Commissions, that will process them as independent Data Controllers for institutional purposes and/or pursuant to the law during investigations and controls. Moreover, your Data may be communicated to third parties (for example, partners, professionals, etc.) that will process them as independent Data Controllers to carry out activities that are instrumental to the above purposes.

7. Data Transfer

The Data Controller does not transfer data outside the European Union. If a transfer should become necessary, in accordance with privacy regulations, the Controller assesses the impact of data transfers and adopts, if applicable, the most appropriate safeguards (e.g., adequacy decisions or standard contractual clauses).

8. Data Subjects' rights

The Data Controller informs you that you, as Data Subject, where the limitations provided by law are not applicable, have the right to:

- obtain confirmation over the existence or nonexistence of Personal Data relating you, even if not yet registered, and their communication in a comprehensible way;
- obtain the indication and, if necessary, the copy of the: a) source and category of the Personal Data; b) logic applied in case the processing is performed by means of electronic instruments; c) purposes and modalities of the processing; d) identification references of the Data Controller and the Data Processors; e) subjects or categories of subjects to whom Personal Data may be communicated or who may come to know, in particular if recipients are extra-EU countries or international organisations; f) period for which the Personal Data will be stored, or if that is not possible, the criteria used to determine that period; g) existence of an automated decision-making process and, in this case, information about the logic involved, the significance and consequences for the data subject;
- h) existence of adequate safeguards in case of transfer of Personal Data to an extra-EU country or international organisation;
- obtain, without undue delay, the update, the rectification or, whether you are interested, the integration of incomplete Data;
- revoke the consents granted at any time, easily, without impediments, using, when possible, the same channels used to provide them;
- obtain the cancellation, the transformation into anonymous form or blocking of the Data: a) processed in breach of the law; b) no longer necessary in relation to the purposes for which the Data have been collected or subsequently processed; c) if you withdraw consent on which the processing is based and there is no other legal ground for the processing; d) if you object to the processing and there are no overriding legitimate grounds for the processing; e) in compliance with a legal obligation; f) referred to minors. The Data Controller may refuse to erase them when the processing is necessary: a) to exercise the right of freedom of expression and information; b) in compliance with a legal obligation, for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority; c) for reasons of public interest; d) to achieve purposes in the

public interest, scientific or historical research purposes or statistical purposes; e) for making legal claims;

- obtain the restriction of processing when: a) the accuracy of the Personal Data is contested; b) the processing is unlawful and the data subject opposes the erasure of the Personal Data; c) Data are required by you for your exercising of legal claims; d) pending verification whether the legitimate grounds of the controller override those of the data subject;

- receive the Personal Data concerning you in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and transmit those data to another controller without hindrance from the controller to which the personal data have been provided, where the processing is carried out by automated means;

The Subscriber authorises Fondazione ITS, with registered office in Via della Cassa di Risparmio, 10, 34121 Trieste, VAT no. 01324230323, Tax Code 90112870325 (hereinafter "Fondazione ITS"), as part of International Talent Support ITS Contest 2027 (hereinafter "ITS Contest 2027"), to carry out some photographic images and/or audio-video recordings depicting one's own person (hereinafter the "Image"), as well as to spread and publish them, through all the media, social network (e.g. Facebook, Instagram) and means that Fondazione ITS deems appropriate, in the manner described in this release and in the subsequent statement, without limits of duration or territory.

To this end, the Subscriber:

I. expressly authorises Fondazione ITS to collect and process my Image in the terms explained in the Privacy Statement above;

II. expressly accepts, as of now, that Fondazione ITS will have the right to carry out, publish and disseminate by any means (by way of example only, but not limited to: internet, paper, video, billboards, social network, etc.) the Image, together with the name also through the incorporation of the same in contributions to be used for advertising and promotional purposes (hereinafter "Contributions" or "Contribution");

III. recognises and accepts, from now on, the discretion of Fondazione ITS to reproduce, process, modify and print the Image in any format for the purposes of dissemination and publication that is the subject of this release;

VI. guarantees, also, to be of age and that there are no rights or claims of third parties relating to their Image;

VII. hold harmless and indemnify Fondazione ITS from any claim by third parties that conflict with the statements and guarantees assumed with this release declaration;

VIII. acknowledges of having nothing to claim against Fondazione ITS for one's own participation in this initiative and for all the subject matter of this release;

IX. acknowledges that Fondazione ITS will not use the Image and/or Contributions in contexts that may harm your honor or reputation;

X. this release declaration supersedes, replaces and cancels any previous communication and/or verbal or written agreement relating to the subject matter hereof.
