In this activity the participants, in pairs or teams, will take on the roles of narrator and designer. The narrator will have the task of describing one of the many curious objects of the ITS Academy heritage to his partner, who will have to draw exclusively following the instructions given orally.

In order to be able to successfully describe something to other people, one must observe carefully, down to the smallest details, the shades of color and the materials. And whoever is in charge of the design must concentrate and listen, to be as faithful as possible to the description and unleash their imagination to get as close as possible to the original creative ideas of the ITS Academy designers.

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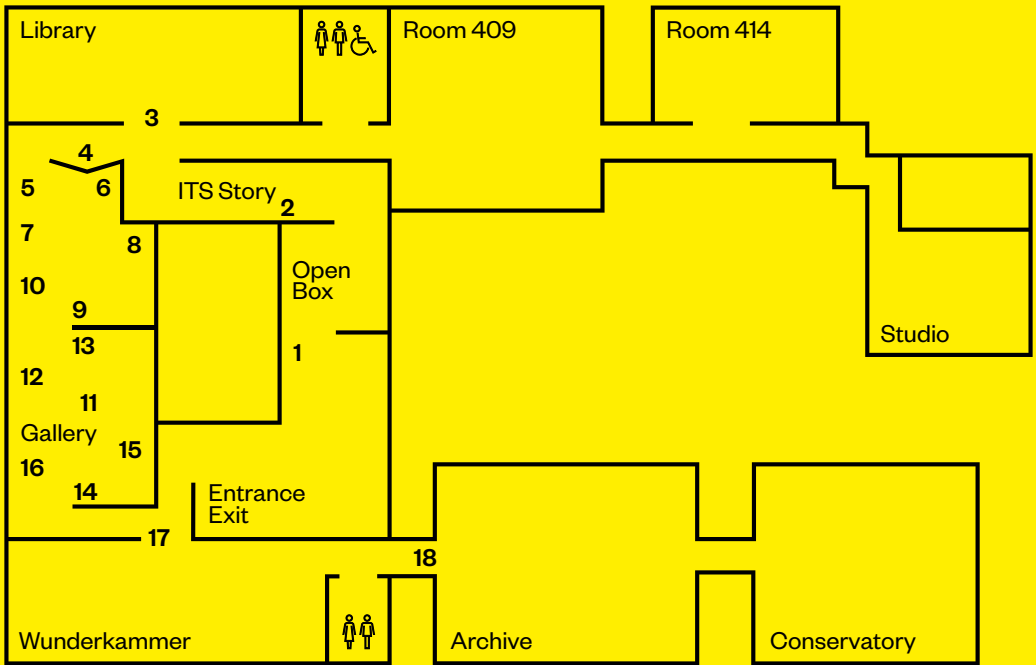
The Art in Fashion: ITS Arcademy
